

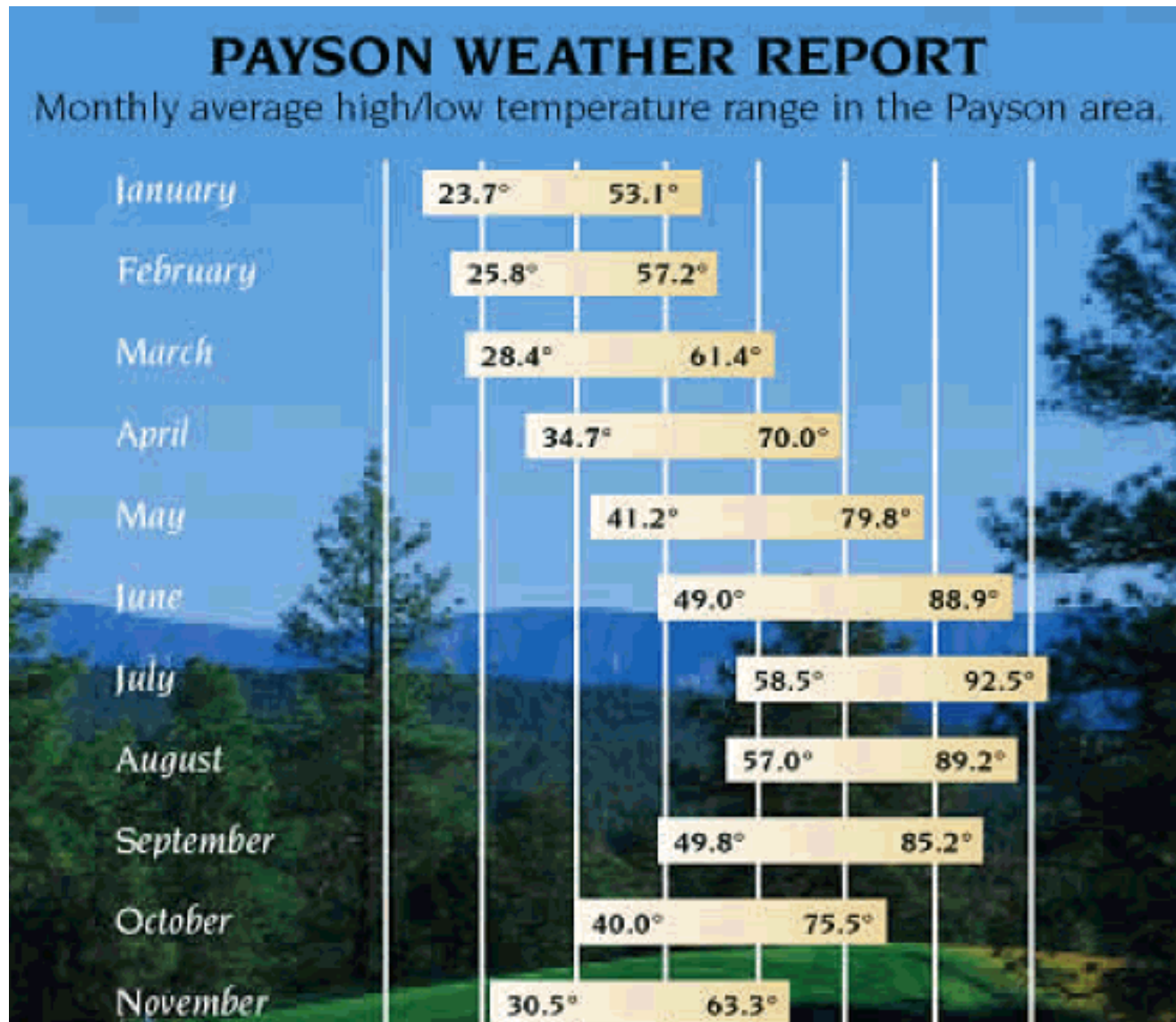
Chaparral Pines

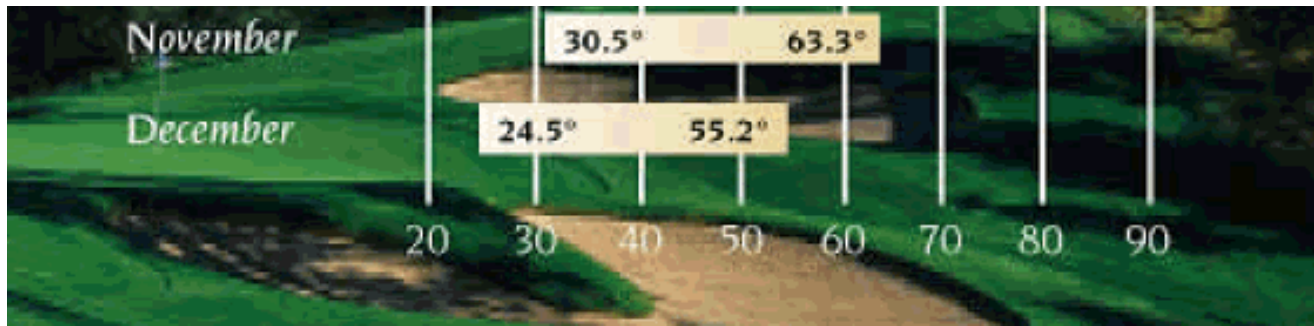
Chaparral Pines is renown for award-winning golf - names by Golf Digest as one of the "Top Ten New Private Golf Courses in the U.S."

The eight-acre Trailhead Park offers complete family oriented recreational facilities and a unique children's playground. Members are encouraged to consider the 24,000-square-foot clubhouse an extension of their own home at Chaparral Pines. The entire community is connected by a trail system that also provides access directly into the adjoining Tonto National Forest.

Area Information

The town of Payson , situated in the heart of Arizona , offers an array of amenities for the residents of Chaparral Pines. The area's beautiful natural surroundings make it easy to see why this quaint town is renowned for its picture-perfect setting and ample recreational activities - and it's only an hour-and-a-half drive from downtown Phoenix . Whether you want to play a round of golf, or venture through the steep hills of the Mogollon Rim, opportunities abound.





Natural beauty of Payson

- Hike more than 240 miles of Forest Service trails in the Tonto National Forest . The forest hugs the side of the Mogollon Rim, which extends for 200 miles. If you'd rather drive the rim, venture out on Rim Road , which offers 42 miles of mountain-clinging terrain that climbs to more than 8,000 feet.
- Utilize the 2.9 million acres of the Tonto National Forest for picnicking, camping, boating, fishing, horseback riding and hunting.
- Visit the world's largest natural travertine (calcium carbonate), Tonto National Bridge Creek, only 10 miles north of Payson.
- Enjoy three lakes, four miles of walking paths and a children's playground at Green Valley Park .

Other activities in and around Payson

- The Rim Country Museum illustrates the history of the area through attractive displays, artifacts and stories.
- Explore the area's prehistoric past at the Shoo-Fly Indian archaeological site.
- Payson boasts the World's Oldest Continuous Rodeo, which began in 1884, every August and the Spring Pro Rodeo in May.
- Ski lovers will enjoy cross-country skiing opportunities and cabin rentals at the Forest Lake Touring Center .
- Gila County Community College offers classes and degree programs and is only one mile west of Chaparral Pines and The Rim Golf Club.

Surrounding communities

- Surrounded by the Tonto National Forest , the town of Young , in Pleasant Valley , attracts campers, fishermen and hunters. It is only 33 miles from Payson.
- The sister communities of Pine and Strawberry, separated by only three miles, offer the Blue Ridge Reservoir, Bear Canyon Lake, Knoll Lake and many more recreational outlets just 15 miles north of Payson.
- Only 90 miles separates Payson and the bustling metropolis of Phoenix . Venture south to enjoy all the arts and entertainment venues, exquisite dining facilities and professional football, baseball, basketball and hockey.
